Sheffield Springs Academy has a score of 0.65 for 2016/17 placing us in the **top 5** of Sheffield Schools. National data placed us in the top 10%.

Progress 8 has now been introduced for all schools. This new measure is based on students' progress measured across eight subjects.

A Progress 8 score will be calculated for each pupil by comparing their achievement with the average score of all pupils nationally who had a similar starting point (or 'prior attainment'), calculated using assessment results from the end of primary school.

The greater the Progress 8 score, the greater the progress made by the pupil compared to the average of pupils with similar prior attainment.

A school's Progress 8 score will be calculated as the average of its pupils' Progress 8 Scores. It will give an indication of whether, as a group, pupils in the school made above or below average progress compared to similar pupils in other schools.

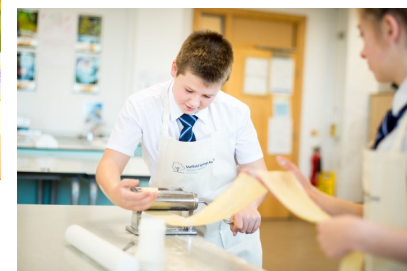
