UCAS Progress and Careers Guidance

Revision Idea

Revision Cards are a great way to revise short, key pieces of information in the run up to an assessment or an exam. A pack of revision cards costs around £4 for 250 (www.amazon.co.uk) and even the act of creating them is a great way to revise key facts, you can then look back at them and quiz yourself on the content. You can even use them to quiz your friends, see

who can get the most correct answers in a set amount of time.

The trick to great revision cards is to only include vital information (for example, in physics just a key equation and the details of how to rearrange it). Make cards colourful and interesting and use images to jog your memory as this could help you in the exam.
